Welcome to Brookneal’s Annual Christmas Parade. The parade will be held on Thursday, December 1, 2016 at 7 p.m. Line up will begin at designated areas around 6 p.m. Please be sure to get your number and have it displayed on the left side of your vehicle or float so it can be judged. The parade route will be organizing in three areas (floats and antique vehicles at the bottom of Old Main Street, walking groups and bands at the Brookneal Post Office, American Legion, JROTC, and grand marshal at the Wilson Electric parking lot and civic vehicles on Main Street from the post office down by Food Lion) and will proceed up Main Street past the judges at the community building and continue on to 40 east to Brookneal Baptist Church parking lot.

All entries must be Christmas theme oriented. We encourage entries to display blue and black ribbons to honor fallen and current police officers. Entries that wish to throw candy are encouraged to have someone on the side of their float or vehicle to throw candy into the crowd as there have been some safety issues with children running in front of vehicles to retrieve candy. 1st place trophies will be awarded for the following 5 categories, Business, Civic, Religious, Antique Vehicle, and Antique Tractor. Marching Bands will be judged separately. There will be no ATVs or four wheelers. **All participating vehicles must be 20 years old or older and considered a classic vehicle (the only exception being for cars that have pageant or beauty queens and grand marshal’s vehicle).** All applications should be in no later than November 28, 2016. We look forward to a wonderful Christmas celebration in our town. Date will be announced in case of inclement weather.
